Note 3-Five graduate programs were in the Graduate School in Fall 2014 and moved to different colleges in Fall 2015. They are now in the College of Health Professions [Genetic Counseling (MS) and Communication Sciences and Disorders (MS)] and College of Public Health [Epidemiology (PhD), Health Promotion and Prevention Research (PhD), and Health Systems Research (PhD)].(8/17/2018 updated)

Note 4-The methodology for reporting applications changed as of Fall 2018. Only fall applications and acceptance data were included to correspond with the fall enrollment columns. For programs that utilize a centralized application service (CAS), only applicants with a CAS and UAMS online application (OAA) were included in the application count. All colleges except nursing and graduate school have at least one program that utilizes a CAS. In the past CAS applicants who did not submit an OAA may have been included in application numbers.
