Note 2-The methodology for reporting applications changed as of Fall 2018. Only **fall** applications and acceptance data were included to correspond with the fall enrollment columns. For programs that utilize a centralized application service (CAS), only applicants with a CAS and UAMS online application (OAA) were included in the application count. All colleges except nursing and graduate school have at least one program that utilizes a CAS. In the past CAS applicants who did not submit an OAA may have been included in application numbers.

Note 3-In Fall 2020 three PhD programs moved from the College of Public Health to the Graduate School. Three programs are: Epidemiology, Health Promotion and Prevention Research, and Health Services Research.
